#### October Meeting Recap – (Stacey Taylor)

Motion was made by Papa member to approve October 2017 Minutes, other Papa member seconded approval and overall Aye Votes, no Nays nor Abstained.

**Haunted House** – Est total \$8,500 with 2,000 tickets sold and \$675 in concessions. For next year's Haunted House, they might cut Mon, Tues, Wed shows. Will sell tickets online in packets of 3 consecutive shows to maximize sales. May not schedule Haunted House during the same week as the band concert dates due to possible conflict in schedule and ticket market share.

**Mattress Fundraiser** – Total earnings \$12,000 with \$1,200 going to student referrals as Amazon gift cards and \$10,800 to PAPA. Last year PAPA made \$9K. \$25 Amazon card to each student referral. Made more money this year but sold fewer mattresses (64 beds).

Proposal to change this fundraiser as a dedicated Marching Band/Colorguard fundraiser. We can rally around a smaller group of kids and parents since we get them together a few times already and engage them to focus on this fundraiser. Of the 45 referrals, 42 were from marching band people. If this becomes a MB fundraiser, then Marching Band will not receive \$4000 from the general fund. Lara B. to discuss with the Theater people.

Other ideas to improve fundraiser:

- Stress to the band community that we do not expect our families to buy a mattresses but to reach out to the community for purchase.
- Notify the Leigh community sooner of the upcoming Mattresses Fundraiser either in the Registration forms that gets sent out in the Spring or in Kara's school bulletins.

## **District Fingerprinting**

Two types of volunteers (District Definition)

- ▶ Level 1: Fingerprint Clearance Required. Volunteers who will have <u>direct contact with</u> students on a consistent basis.
  - Examples include volunteer work with school activities and clubs, sports, dance teams, **marching band**, assisting in the office.
- Level 2: Volunteers with <u>no direct contact with students on a consistent basis without certificated personnel</u>.

- Examples include attending a one-time event, serving as a guest speaker, assisting with a field trip.
- ▶ It is preferred if a Level 1 volunteer or certified professional be present when Level 2 volunteers are in direct contact with students
- ▶ Activities Director's Perspective for PAPA: a PAPA parent who volunteers for the rummage sale and to sell tickets at the Haunted House would not need to go through clearance. However, someone who will interact with students directly at ALL or MOST of your fundraisers throughout the year would become a Level 1.
  - Contact Crystal to get processed
